

Privacy Policy for Proud Foundation Repair, LLC.

What information do we collect?

We collect information from you when you enter our website including, but not limited to, ip-address, website you have visited from, searches you have made before coming to our site, location data, any other data, and any information you provide when signing up for a FREE estimate or any other offers.

How do we use your information?

We will contact you about your request you made via our web site. We may use your information to follow up about products, services, appointments, etc., and to study user behavior to improve the quality of our web site and services. We may also use your information to enable us to display advertisements to our advertisers target audiences. If you have opted-in to receive our e-mail newsletter, we may send you periodic e-mails. If you would no longer like to receive promotional e-mails from us, please reply to any emails asking to remove you from our list.

How do we protect visitor information?

We implement a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of your personal information. Your personal information is contained behind secured networks and is only accessible by a limited number of persons who have special access rights to such systems, and are required to keep the information confidential. Any payment transactions and any other identifying information will be encrypted using SSL technology.

Do we use "cookies" or "sessions"?

Yes. Certain features of our website use Cookies. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse tracking and analytic files, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our website.

Cookies are small files that a site or its service provider transfers to your computer's hard drive through your Web browser (if you allow) that enables the sites or service providers systems to recognize your browser and capture and remember certain information.

How do we use "cookies" or "sessions"?

Primarily we use cookies to help us compile aggregate data about site traffic and site interaction so that we can offer better site experiences and tools in the future. They are also used to help us understand your preferences based on previous or current site activity, which enables us to provide you with improved services.

Our website uses Display Advertising and Remarketing with Google Analytics to advertise online. This means that third-party vendors, including Google, will display our ads on sites across the internet. We and third-party vendors, including Google, use first-party cookies (such as the Google Analytics cookie) and third-party cookies (such as the DoubleClick cookie) together. Additional Adwords features we specifically use include: affinity audiences, custom affinity audiences, in-market audiences, similar audiences and demographic & location targeting. The reason we use these features is to best inform, optimize and serve ads most relevant to you.

We also use these cookies to receive reports on ad impressions, other uses of ad services & interactions with these ad impressions and how ad services relate to visits to our website. Display Advertising allows us to use Google Analytics Demographics and Interest Reporting. These features collect information such as, but not limited to, age, gender and interest categories.

How do we protect your personally identifiable information?

We do not facilitate the merging of personally identifiable information (last name, phone address, etc.) with non-personally identifiable information previously collected from Display Advertising features that is based on the DoubleClick cookie. Do we disclose the information we collect to outside parties?

We do not sell, trade, or otherwise transfer to outside parties certain personally identifiable information (including your last name, house number, street name, phone number and email address) unless we provide you with advance notice, except as described below.

The term "outside parties" does not include website hosting partners and other parties who assist us in operating our website, conducting our business, or servicing you, so long as those parties agree to keep this information confidential. We may also release your information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law, enforce our site policies, or protect the rights, property, or safety of ourselves or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organizations for the purposes of fraud protection and credit risk reduction. We may also disclose your information to a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of Proud Foundation Repair, LLC., assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by Proud Foundation Repair, LLC., about our website users is among the assets transferred.
